We would like not only to give your child a basis for learning, but also to help him develop the Islamic character traits that will benefit him the rest of his life. Communication is vital throughout the school year.


At any point in the year, don't hesitate to discuss your child's development with us.

To assist your child during this year, here are several projects and suggestions you may follow:

- 1 Read daily to your child from books designed for a kindergartner. (2-5 years appropriate) Read and tell him stories about Allah, Prophets, Ask comprehension questions.
- 2 Sing songs and listen to good Nazms with him.
- 3 Encourage your child to cut out large pictures.
- 4 Discuss colors. He should learn the names of basic colors -- red, blue, green, yellow, orange, purple, brown and black.
- 5 Work simple puzzles together.
- 6 Help your child practice zipping, buttoning, typing and putting on wearing apparel.
- 7 Encourage your child to do as much as he can by himself. Give him specific responsibilities of which he is capable, expect him to do them, and praise him for each effort.
- 8 Encourage your child to play with you, with other children and alone.
- 9 Give him a nutritious breakfast each morning and provide a fruit snack for his mid-morning break.
- 10 Help him practice courtesies in keeping in keeping with his age and development.
- Help him feel secure and wanted, show an interest in all he does.
- 12 Lead your child to appreciate the wonders of Allah's creative handiwork and His great love for our Nabi (SAW)
- 13 Teach him to pray, and pray with him. Help him to memorize short surahs and duaahs.
- 14 Take him to Mosque, Islamic gatherings regularly.

Your Child is like a vessel just waiting to be filled. With your help, We desire to fill him with Godly character, as well as to to give him a solid basis for relating to his immediate World. The foundation for learning this year will affect him for a life time. We are looking forward to a grat year together!

DISCIPLINE IN THE LEARNING CENTRE

- Specific rules should be established to maintain discipline in the classroom.
 a.As the children begin to feel "at home" in the class ,a list of "dos and don'ts"
 Becomes more and more necessary.
 - b. The learning center should be a place where children like to come!
 - c. A child is not just being disciplined for the moment, his life ids being molded.

Examples of rules might be:

- 1. Walk inside; run outside
- 2. Listen when the teacher is talking
- 3. Crayons are for paper not walls
- 4. Stay in your seat
- 5. Be kind to others; do not fight
- B. A "list" of class rules serves four purposes:
- 1. The class atmosphere is more conducive to learning.
- 2. Learning to remember and obey rules builds character and prepares the children for living.
- 3. Maintaining fairness to each individual child and consistency of discipline is much easier. (Children soon realize that infractions are dealt with in exactly the same way each time, for each child.)
- 4. Rules keep the teacher from "nagging" ("I've told you three times. . . .!")

RULES FOR BREAKTIME

Rules to be discussed with the children:

- 1 Kidz may not go beyond boundaries if they do, they will receive a demerit.
- 2 Things that may and may not be thrown
- 3 The line up signal
- When they may & may not go near the equipment (Be careful when someone is swinging etc.)
- 5 taking turns & sharing (balls etc.)
- 6 Only leaving play area when signalled, No running out by oneself,
- 7 No standing near to doors being electrically opened.
- 8 No running to parents vehicles parked on the road.



SECURITY

Only authorised persons are allowed to fetch your child.

NOTE

Our children do not have TV-knees; they love the outdoors and learn through playing. Messy play, walking barefoot on the grass and playing in the sandpit all develops their skills and enhancesintelligence.

CHILDREN'S CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Please send your child to school in practical, comfortable clothing that will in no way inhibit his/her development.

Children learn through their senses and by experimenting in their environment. Please allow your children to play and learn freely without being overly concerned about dirt or damage.

- Please send a spare change of clothing to school in your child's bag each day
- Please include a jersey for cooler weather.
- Hats are compulsory in summer.
- All clothing should be clearly marked with your child's name.



WHEN YOUR CHILD IS SICK

If your little one are not feeling well, have a bad cold or if they were sick during the previous night, must not attend school and should preferably be kept at home until they are better; So kindly contact us via phone call or sms to notify us.

KIDZ N' MUMZ CALENDAR

We follow the Gauteng School Holiday calendar. We close on Public Holidays, and we make provision for long weekends and Religious / Auspicious days. (Kids may be given added days off)



1. Hours of Playgroup

School begins at 9:30am and ends at 12:30pm. Parents are asked to please drop their children no later than 9:30am.

Parents are to accompany their children to their classroom. Children are to be fetched personally by their parents and if another party will be fetching your child, please notify us in due time. No child will be allowed to leave the playgroup premises without prior notification.

1. Pigeon holes

A pigeon hole is allocated to each child in the Playgroup. This is how we communicate with you – all notices, newsletters and party invitations are placed in your child's box. Please check the plastic pocket folder daily.

School bags

Each child must have his / her own named school bag which contains a change of clothing. This teaches your child to look after and put away his / her belongings. All clothes should be properly marked to avoid losses.

Toys at school

Bringing toys to school often results in tears, especially when they are broken. Please if possible, leave them at home. Please note that every care is taken to look after the toys that are sent to school, but we cannot be held responsible for toys that are lost.

4. Labelling of personal items

Please ensure that all items that are sent to school are clearly labelled with your child's name and surname. This includes sun hats, lunch boxes and juice bottles.

School equipment

If school equipment finds its way home, please return it. Ensure that the child is aware that they have to return it to school.

6. Personal information

Parents are asked to keep kidz n' Mumz informed of any personal information changes such as postal or physical address, cell and home numbers etc. This is to enable us to contact you in case of an emergency and it is essential that we have the correct telephone numbers.

7. Waste materials
